

FOXX POOLS BY CHARLES BURGER

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CLOSING TO DO'S?

1 - BALANCE

Alkalinity: Acidity of pool needs to be in range so chemicals work and the pool surface is not damaged.

PH - Balance in range so pool chemicals work

CALCIUM HARDNESS: This is the forgotten item! If Calcium is out of range in winter, that is when your pool surface suffers. Your pool surface has a certain level of Calcium in it. If it is too low, then it will pull the calcium out of the liner / fiberglass / gunite. If too high, then you form scale on surface (rough / gritty).

2 - KILL

Super chlorinate the pool to kill any algae after water is balanced.

- Power 73, Quick Shock or Power Magic AC

Add Shock-N-Swim to the pool to break up nitrogen / ammonia build up from chlorine.

Add Micro-floc Clarifier to pool to pull all live and dead microscopic algae out of water into filter.

3 - PROTECT

FOR MESH COVER POOLS - 1 bottle Spring / Fall for 20,000 gallons.

FOR ALL POOLS - Add 1 qt. winter aid for 20,000 gallons.

SALT and / or Pools that have staining - use a stain scale protectant.

Pumps - Spray Pump Protector for protection of motor seals and assemblies.

4 - CLEAN

Solar covers - Wash down with a cover cleaner

Filter - Earth / Fiber Clear: Backwash, then take apart and soak with FILTER CLEANER

Cartridge Filters - Hose out well, then soak or spray with Filter Cleaner

Rinse out filter hoses / vacuum hoses.

Wash equipment with a bit of cleaner to eliminate chlorine buildup on brushes / nets / vac heads.
